Len was a member of Goleta Valley Council 5300. In the last years of his life, he made his home with his daughter Julie Mooy and granddaughter Jo Bittner and family. He would have been 107 years old in July.

Valentine and son-in-law Len Mooy. He was a loving father to all and the loss is overwhelming.
