ST FRANCIS XAVIER


At the age of 24, St Francis Xavier, a young college philosophy teacher in Paris with a promising career in the academic field finally heeded the call to follow Jesus through the urgings of a persuasive and persistent St Ignatius of Loyola. Afterwards, St Francis made the 30-day Spiritual Exercises under St Ignatius direction. He joined the newly formed Jesuits in 1534. He vowed to live a life of poverty, chastity and apostolic service according to the directions of the Pope. At Venice in 1537, he was ordained a priest. He spent the rest of his life as a missionary to Eastern Asian Islands like Malaysia, Japan. He lived among the poorest of the poor. He tirelessly ministered to them with the joy as related in his letters. A Portuguese merchant tending to St Francis before he dies recalls that he could see that St Francis was dying and put a lighted candle in his hand. Then, with the name of Jesus on his lips, he gave his spirit to his Creator and Lord with great peace and repose. St Francis died on the island of Sancian, about 100 miles southwest of Hong Kong in 1552. He is the patron saint of foreign missionaries.
