STORY OF SAINT JOSEPH

The Bible paid Joseph the highest compliment. He was a "just" man. To justify a person make right, is God's initiative and doing not the person. However, the person has the choice to respond to God or not. When the Bible spoke of God "justifying" someone, it meant that the all-holy all-loving God transformed a person. The individual shared somehow in God's own holiness as He showered His love upon the person. By saying Joseph was "just," the Bible meant that he was one who was completely open to all that God wanted to do for him. He became holy by opening himself totally to God.

It is no contradiction of Joseph's manly holiness that he decided to divorce Mary when she was found to be with child. The important words of the Bible are that he planned to do this "quietly" because he was "a righteous man, yet unwilling to expose her to shame" (Matthew 1:19).

The just man was simply, joyfully, wholeheartedly obedient to God in marrying Mary, in naming Jesus, in shepherding the precious pair to Egypt, in bringing them to Nazareth, in the undetermined number of years of quiet faith and courage.

The rest we can easily surmise. Think of the kind of love with which he wooed and won Mary, and the depth of the love they shared during their marriage.

Reflection

The Bible tells us nothing of Joseph in the years after the return to Nazareth except the incident of finding Jesus in the Temple (Luke 2:41–51). Perhaps this can be taken to mean that God wants us to realize that the holiest family was like every other family, that the circumstances of life for the holiest family were like those of every family, so that when Jesus' mysterious nature began to appear, people could not believe that he came from such humble beginnings: "Is he not the carpenter's son? Is not his mother named Mary...?" (Matthew 13:55a). It was almost as indignant as "Can anything good come from Nazareth?" (John 1:46b).

Saint Joseph is the Patron Saint of Belgium, Canada, China, Peru, Russia, Vietnam, Carpenters, Workers, Fathers, Happy Death, Social Justice, Travelers, and Universal Church.
