**Saint for February-- St. Blaise** (also spelled St. Blase) (Feast day Feb. 3) He was the bishop of Sebastea, Armenia. He was imprisoned, tortured, and beheaded as part of the Christian persecution in 316 A.D. Most of us will remember the feast of St. Blaise when we would all get a throat blessing using two crossed candles by a priest at Mass.†

**Saint for March-- St. Patrick** (Feast Day March 17) Often referred to as "the Apostle of Ireland", he was captured by raiders at the age of 16 and was carried off in slavery to pagan Ireland. He seems to have managed to return to Britain and later studied at the monastery of Lêrins from 412 through 415. About 432 he was consecrated a bishop and sent back to Ireland. Where he eventually converted most of the island to Christianity.†

Below is a final letter from our retiring insurance agent, George Majouie:

#### Worthy Brothers,

First, thank you for your good works in organizing and distributing your respective monthly/quarterly newsletters. For many brother Knights and their families, this is the only connection between your council and them. It is unfortunate that so many brothers are disconnected from their councils.

#### Points to consider:

- 1. Is there a possible activity your council can organize to bring some of these "lost" brothers back to you?
- 2. How about a letter from your Grand Knight with a focus on **Remember Why!** 
  - a. Why did you join the Knights of Columbus XX years ago?
  - b. Do you remember who your sponsor is/was?
  - c. What activity most interested you? Why?
  - d. Etc.
- 3. Consider creating a spreadsheet of all inactive and prior Knights.
  - a. Host a meeting of current active members and spread out on a table the names and contact information of those brother Knights who are no longer attending.
  - b. Invite those in attendance to go through the list/contact card for each Knight they personally know.
  - c. That Knight then calls the inactive Knight with the focus of getting them to join in a community/council event.
  - d. A report of calls made and responses from the inactive Knights is presented and all are collated and reviewed by the Officers.

4. Most of our current, active Knights do not know why prior/inactive Knights are no longer active. Could it be a lack of communication? Not taking the time to reach out to a brother in need? Does the brother have transportation challenges? Does the brother have financial challenges preventing him from paying dues? (This can be handled easily if there is a true financial need.)

These are just some of my final thoughts regarding reaching out to our lost brothers and the important role you have as Newsletter/Bulletin Editor. This is my final Insurance Agent Article for submission. God bless you in all you are and do. Thank you.
