Do you have coverage?

Andrew Leicht Earns Eagle Scout Ranking From Los Padres Eagle Board of Review

Andrew Leicht, member of the Boy Scout Troop 105, has been awarded the Eagle Scout Rank as his Eagle Scout project benefitting St. Raphael Parish Rectory was completed in late February.

Andrew's undertaking was to improve the St. Raphael security by installing an outside and inside intercom system and an electric strike lock on the Rectory front door.

Maria Romero, receptionist, remarked, "Andrew is very bright, reliable, flexible and willing to listen to my views while working on his special project. Maria added, "The new security system is most beneficial and helpful to me as I work at my desk. Hearing the door bell many times each day, now it is less stressful as I am aware of who may be at the door and thus without getting up, may let the person enter to see me. It provides us with extra security before the door is opened."

The Bishop Garcia Diego senior went before the local Los Padres Council Eagle Board of Review on Thursday, March 24. They questioned him for nearly an hour on his Boy Scouting career and his special project. Afterwards, the Board congratulated Andrew for his Eagle Scout Ranking.

Andrew acknowledged, "Many people donated time and money to my project and to Thomas

Schiferl's project especially by way of purchasing raffle tickets (\$3,187 worth) for a grand prize of one week in a fully furnished South Lake Tahoe home near Heavenly Ski Resort." He added, "The Knights generously donated \$200 to our cause."

Andrew would advise anyone attempting to earn the rank of Eagle to 'start now.' He exclaimed, "The projects take more time than is expected and waiting until the last minute or even the last year is never a good idea."

Back in 2000 Andrew became a Cub Scout with the intention to make Eagle. He explained, "The highlights of scouting are taking camping trips, the camaraderie, partaking in rocket launches in Mojave and going on all the outings."

After graduation on June 4 from Bishop High School with a class of around 75, Andrew plans to attend either Gonzaga University or Loyola Marymount University next fall majoring in Engineering.

His parents, Edward and Jacqui (Grainger) were married in St. Raphael Church by Father John Higgins on September 16, 1989. They are proud of their three children: Megan, 19, was Class Valedictorian at Bishop in 2010 and is currently attending the University of Notre Dame, majoring in Architecture; Andrew for his many years as an Altar Server, Boy Scout and golfing partner; and Sarah who is in the 7th grade at St. Raphael School.

Edward joined the Knights of Columbus this Columbian Year. He has been working as General Manager of Implantech for 18 years and Jacqui works at the Parish Rectory as the Finance Manager for St. Raphael Church.

Brother Knights Edward and Scoutmaster Glenn Schiferl were co-chairpersons for the successful St. Raphael Festival held on Sunday, Sept. 26.


