



## Happy 94th Birthday on April 18th

Mario F. Borgatello was born on April 18, 1918 in Santa Barbara, California, the youngest of five children to Secondo Borgatello and Josephine Prato Borgatello. Six short months after Mario was born, Secondo passed away leaving Josephone to raise five young children on her own. Times were very tough and they did the best that they could to get by on a daily basis with much help from Santa Barbara County Social Services. As a way to feed the family, Josephine began providing boarding for the immigrants that would come from Italy as gardeners and stone masons.

In the late 1920's Mario and his older brother Charles started collecting food scraps to help feed the hogs that their mom was raising. Over the years this hauling business has evolved into what is now known as MarBorg Industries. In 1938 Mario met Marguerite Saulsburg, the love of his life. They were married in November of 1941 at St. Joan of Arc Church in Las Vegas. Mario and Marguerite (Peggy) were married for 70-years and had two sons, David and Mario Jr. Peggy died June 1, 2011. Since then the family has blossomed to 7 grandchildren and 21 great-grandchildren. ## Proposed Council Resolution for Catholic Textbooks for St. Raphael's School

At the meeting of the Officers of the Knights of Columbus Goleta Valley Council 5300 on March 5<sup>th</sup> 2012, the following resolution was proposed and approved by the Officers:

#### Resolved:

Whereas the mission of the Catholic Schools Textbook Project is to provide history and social studies textbooks to Catholic Elementary Schools that teach about the world while giving the Catholic Church the position it deserves in history without exaggerating either favorable or unfavorable realities.

Whereas the mission of St. Raphael's Catholic School is to provide a Catholic education to its students.

Whereas the Knights of Columbus, Goleta Valley Council 5300 supports the mission of the Catholic Schools Textbook Project and St. Raphael's Catholic School.

That the Knights of Columbus Goleta Valley Council 5300 will donate to St. Raphael's Catholic Elementary School an amount totaling to \$6,854.98 that will be spread out in quarterly installments to St. Raphael's School for the purchasing of these textbooks for Grades 5 through 7.

## Boy Scout Troop 105 Collects 2,300 Pounds of Food for Santa Barbara Food Bank on Saturday, March 10

Boy Scout Troop 105 recently participated in the food drive known as *Scouting for Food*. Held annually across the nation, the local South Coast District of the Los Padres Council held their drive on March 10<sup>th</sup>.

In this area, the food is donated to the Santa Barbara Food Bank to help their mission to serve the needy. Glenn Schiferl, Scoutmaster, praised the Troop members, stating, "The boys and their parents work real hard to provide service to their community. The community response to their efforts has been great. The boys range from 6<sup>th</sup> grade to age 18, and work together as a team. It's important that we instill those habits of service at a young age, and that they learn that many hands make light work – and that service work can be fun."

The Food Bank provides the boys with a hotdog lunch for their efforts. The troops across the district compete to collect the most total food (by weight) and the highest weight collected per boy registered with the Troop. Last year, Troop 105 collected over a ton of food, missing the most total food by about 20 pounds. They did win the distinction of having the most food per boy, with over 95 pounds per boy.

In defending their title, this year the troop collected about 2,300 pounds, and over 127 pounds per boy. The district organizers said this was



the most food ever collected by a single troop. The final winners of the competition are announced at the Scouting skills competition and camping event known as Camporee, held April 20<sup>th</sup>-21<sup>st</sup>.
