



Frank' Joseph Donohoe Jr. was born on May 18, 1937 in Wilmington, Delaware. Frank and Cay (Cyback) were married on Sept. 7, 1963 at the Old Mission Santa Barbara by Father Emmanuel Meusseingang, the Pastor.

Proud parents of four grown children: Patrick, Sharon, Cathleen and Paul. Proud grandparents of Annabel (13) and Jasper (11) van der Meulen and Kadin (12) and Jacob(10) Donohoe. Cay and Frank feel most blessed to have three children and all four grandchildren living in Santa Barbara.

Both Frank and Cay have been active in the St. Raphael and Goleta community since 1963. Frank was one of the three original Eucharistic Ministers in 1969 along with Tony Varesio and Mike Bowers. He has been a member of the Parish Council, teacher in the Jr. High CCD program, Lector and Cantor at Mass. Frank served as the 35th Grand Knight of the Goleta Valley Knights of Columbus during the 1996-97 Columbian year. Now his son Patrick is scheduled to be elected Grand Knight for Columbian year 2012-13, the first "second generation" GK for Council 5300. Frank joined the Knights in Kokomo, Indiana in 1961 and rejoined Council 5300 in 1990 with Ken Kuether as his sponsor.

The Donohoes first met while both were working for Delco in Goleta. Frank came from the Kokomo plant in 1962 while Cay Cyback transferred from GM's Cadillac Division in Cleveland, Ohio.

Frank graduated from St. Thomas the Apostle Grade School in Bloomfield, N.J. and Bloomington High School in 1954. He received his BEE degree in 1958 from Villanova University in Pennsylvania and his MBA in 1983 from Golden Gate Univ., in San Francisco. He served in the U.S. Marine Corps Reserves from 1960-68.

Frank retired in 1995 as a Principal Engineer after 35-years with General Motors Corp. He then worked for Raytheon Company from 1995-2006.

Cay has been a realtor for more than 33-years, presently working with the family owned brokerage. Her parish involvements have included helping with the Parish Centennial Yearbook's portrait scheduling, Finance Committee, Parish Council and Women's Auxiliary.

Farid (Fritz) Assad Mora Earns Eagle Scout Ranking with Challenging Musical Video

Farid (Fritz) Assad Mora became the 5th member of Boy Scout Troop 105 to be awarded the Eagle Scout Rank in the past 16 months.



The soon to be 14-year old (birthdate is May 12, 1998) presented his Scout history and project to three Senior Scout Leaders from the South Coast District who reviewed his scouting career and questioned him on the leadership he demonstrated in completing his special project. On March 15, 2012 the Eagle Scout Review Board approved his advancement to the Eagle Rank.

Fritz's project involved making a promotional video for the Doctors Without Walls-Santa Barbara Street Medicine to promote their sock drive. Fritz explained, "The two groups use socks as an outreach to the homeless in Santa Barbara. They give a pair of socks to the homeless first as an ice-breaker and do this each week until they develop trust in the DWW-SBSM workers." He added, "First of all the homeless want white tube socks...they call these White Gold."

"To get people to watch my video and raise awareness about the group was my first goal and secondly was to have participants to each bring a sixpack of white tube socks donated to DWW-SBSM," emphasized Fritz.

Scoutmaster Glenn Schiferl emphasized, "Fritz, at 13, has been driven since he joined Troop 105. He attended two week-long camps during the summers, including youth leadership training. Using his singing voice and video editing capabilities, his Eagle project demonstrates the wide variety of skillls and talents the community can use." The current 8th grade student at Providence Hall joined Troop 105 in June 2009.

The Eagle Court of Honor was held on Saturday, April 28, in the St. Raphael's Parish Hall.

It was on October 6, 2011 that Fritz chose his successful project, the promotional video spotlighting his extraordinary involvement with the Westmont Choir and Orchestra.

On January 23, 2012 he conducted and recorded the Westmont Choir in singing "Black Socks." Teaching the song "Black Socks" to Westmont Choir singers and conducting the choir without music scores was easy according to Fritz. "It was fun to work with good singers, but for the orchestra, I needed a music score. I could not find a music score on line, so I played it on the piano and transcribed it into a score with the arrangement I wanted and passed the music to the orchestra," pointed out Fritz. He added, "Dr. Michael Shasberger, music director, asked me if I wanted to conduct the orchestra, but I was shocked and asked him to do it for me. He reviewed the arrangement with me, had one rehearsal, then recorded it with three cameras. My dad helped," emphasized Fritz.

The proud parents, Assad and Kathy Patmore Mora, are in private practice, serving as dentist and endodontist in Santa Barbara. Fritz has three sisters: Ann Jeanine, Mary Christine and Clara Grace. Dr. Mora acclaimed, "Fritz was 12 when he appeared in his Boy Scout uniform and sang 'God Bless America' at the Heritage House to entertain the residents on Memorial Day." He added, "At another time he opened the ball games with the National Anthem at Westmont College."

Fritz's strong leadership was demonstrated through planning meeting times, persisting in coordinating meeting times for the Orchestra and Choir, leading the Choir and Orchestra, effectively carrying out his plans, singing in front of the whole Choir and Orchestra and also leading them in singing and playing as a round. Fritz acknowledged, "It was fun and I was applauded at the end which was a bonus for me."

The current 8th grade student at Providence Hall joined Troop 105 in June 2009. His first service project proposal was to develop a nature trail for the Winchester Gun Club in September 2011.

Looking back Fritz said, "I became a Boy Scout to have fun and go camping." He added, "The best thing about being a Boy Scout is getting to try new things that I would have never had the opportunity to try otherwise."

The talented youngster would like to see the Boy Scouts undertake more technological skills.

A few highlights of his Boy Scout experiences include white water rafting, the rock climbing, overnight on the USS Hornet, the National Youth Leadership Training and singing the National Anthem at Scout-o-Rama 2012.

His recommendations why boys and girls should consider becoming scouts are that they would then develop confidence in life skills and experience outdoor adventures.

As an active Troop 105 member, Fritz has participated at St. Raphael Parish Picnics, Knights of Columbus Breakfasts and helping with parking for special events.

His special travel destinations as a Scout include Camp Chawanakee, Camp French-NYLT, Rancho Allegre-Order of the Arrow and 2013 Jamboree.

Fritz has many hobbies of special interest: music, loves to sing, play the piano, draw and paint, read, swim, surf, SCUBA and invent.

In only 14-months Fritz has earned 33 merit badges. These include wood-carving, tracking, scuba, scholarship, rifle shooting, reading, pioneering, pets, music, mammal study, life saving, leatherwork, Indian lore, gardening, flyfishing, dentistry, cinematography, canoeing, basketry, art and archery. The 12 badges required for his Eagle Scout Ranking are: Family Life, Personal Fitness, Personal Management, Swimming, First Aid, Environmental Science, Emergency Prepaparedness, Communications, Citizenship in the World, Citizenship in the Nation, Citizenship in the Community and Camping.

When asked what is his next step after his Eagle Scout Ranking, Fritz emphasized, "Serve my Troop 105, be a good representative of the Boy Scouts of America, earn Eagle Palms which are the merit badges that could be earned after becoming an Eagle Scout and do more of the fun outdoor activities."
