Positive News on TV Programming

You have read many columns in this Knightline based on information from the Parents Television Council about the sorry state of television programing. The PTC has documented the sexual and violent content of programming and its effects on viewers. The PTC has also appealed for followers to support campaigns against advertisers of such programming and letter writing to industry and to government legislative and executive leaders.

The PTC has documented that the television rating system is a dismal failure. For instance, their latest survey examined every PG-rated show in a two-week span and found that 92% of the PG shows airing adult sexual content did not include an "S" (sexual behavior content) content descriptor so that parents could use the industry's vaunted V-chip to prevent exposure of the content to children. During the study period children viewing PG-rated programs would have been exposed to 181 instances of adult sexual content, 239 instances of offensive language, and 217 instances of violence due to misrepresentation of show content using their own rating system.

Now, the PTC has a positive step you can take to protect your children and grandchildren. They have begun a pre-broadcast review of all television programs with the results available to you, the

parents and grandparents of children. You are now able to determine ahead of time, by day, what is suitable for viewing by



your children. Of course, you must still control access to the television for this listing to be effective. You can find the list of programs rated safe for children by the PTC on the internet at http://w2.parentstv.org/main/Toolkit/PTCPicks.aspx

The decorations of good fresh smelling branches was provided by Stan Georgi while the Boy Scout Troop 105 at their Christmas tree lot gave the many fresh greens which circle around their large green skirt. The many beautiful poinsettia plants were given by parishioners.

Parishioners assisting Al Borgaro were Justin Bosio, Reg Calderon, Joe Kovach, James Marchiando, Louis Nungaray, Teo Nungaray and Paul Williams.

Three lights spotlight the Baby Jesus, Mary, Joseph, shephard and oxen. Children of all ages and parents too, are welcome to come up close and see the Baby Jesus in this special Manger.

Borgaro acknowledged, "Lot of different people were involved over these 52-years in putting up the Manger." Al added, "The original platform was much larger and alterations were made over the years. Originally they planned to add another statue each year."



Sam was building a new home for Mary and Dan Grant and the Grants donated the shakes and other lumber for this special Church addition. Al and Henry Borgaro, native Goletans and very active parishioners, did all the work each year in setting up the beautiful manger with the many statues with assistance from other parishioners. For years the complete Christmas Manger was stored at Henry and Georgia Borgaro's home. Al stated, "The late Emma Kunze gave us the pine greens for many years, and son Herb has supplied the hay for the manger since the beginning." Pastor Edward Hempfling originally wanted a full manger setting with all the animals and other statues, but space prevented that in 1961 in the old church. Today little children leave personal messages to Jesus at the manger. The beautiful setting will remain in the Church through Sunday, Jan. 6 according to Al. Special thanks go to Al and his helpers who do this special work of beauty each Christmas season.
