Bro. William also was the Grand Knight of Culver City Council 3542 for both the 1991-92 and 1992-93 Columbian years - a rare distinctive honor to serve in the highest capacity for two councils.

The native of Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania was installed as Grand Knight in an installation ceremony on Saturday night, June 22 at Bishop Diego High School in a joint installation with Council 1684. District Deputy Niceforo Albino Prado performed the impressive rites as all other new officers were also installed. A Centennial Dinner celebration followed.

"The best thing about being a KC member is the chance to be a member of an organization that helps spread the words of Jesus Christ," exclaimed William. A KC event that stands out was when he watch the Color Corps during a Mass celebrated by Pope John Paul II at Dodger Stadium.

William cherishes his years as a KC member because of constantly learning from the vast experiences of fellow Knights. He added, "My goal as Grand Knight is to advance the culture of life by actively working and praying for Pro-Life. He also pointed out, "Men should become members of the Knights of Columbus as it is a time For All Men to come to the aid of Christianity."

His father was from Bloomfield, PA and his mother from Hazelwood, PA with the family living in South Park and Bloomfield. "Dad had limited time being a policeman to devote to the Church but he did devote time to Holy Name Society and Fraternal Order of Police," stated William. William attended Broughton Elementary School and is a 1963 graduate of Scheneley High School in Pittsburgh. He joined the U.S. Navy in 1963 and served on the Mullinix DD944 making cruises to Italy, France and Spain until 1966.

After separation from the Navy he moved to Santa Monica, CA where his sister Paula lived. He received an AA Degree from West Los Angeles College. He then worked at NASA where he was a film splicer sending 16 mm films out to schools. Then in 1968 he started working for GTE (now Verizon) where he was a computer maintainer. In 1997 he received an intercompany transfer to Santa Barbara, retiring in 2000. William holds several certificates from National Radio Institute, Stratford and Penn Foster correspondence schools. He credits his Navy background for his success in his professional career.



Born in Chicago, Illinois, on April 10, 1923, Hal is survived by five children: Ruth, Patricia, Harold, John and Daniel. Six grandchildren are Harold IV, Katharine, Daniel, Sarah, Julia and Jon-Michael.Great-grandsons are Thomas Paul and Harold V.

At age 18 Hal enlisted in the U.S. Navy in 1940 and during his service he received training in Morse Code to serve in communications as a radio operator in the Panama Canal and on a Naval escort ship. Served through 1945 in the Canal Zone and the Philippines.

Hal married Marcella Josephine Sanders on May 12, 1956 at St. Andrews Church in Pasadena by Rev. Harold Laubacher. She was a member of the St. Raphael Choir, other choral groups, musical theater and cantor. She died on June 10, 1993.

Hal completed an AA degree in Electronics at Pasadena City College while working full time and raising a family.

Hal retired in 1978 after 25 years of service with IBM as a computer field engineer and So Cal Gas for 5 years. He enjoyed the remainder of his life living in Santa Barbara. He enjoyed classical music, was an avid golfer, tennis player and bridge player.

Hal joined St. Raphael's parish in 1975. He was a Eucharistic Minister, volunteer for St. Vincent de Paul, a member of Sociable Seniors and also served the community through the Knights of Columbus. He rejoined the KC's on May 13, 1996 with Bernie Jochum his sponsor. He initially joined the KC's in 1947 in Glendale, California.

Hal spent years assisting people in need through the St. Vincent de Paul Society.

Hal was a loving husband, father, grandparent and friend to anyone that met him and will be remembered for his consistent love and dedication to his family and friends.

A vigil with a Rosary at St. Raphael's Church was held on June 13 at 7 p.m. Celebration of Funeral Mass was on June 14 at 10.m.







After one year at St. Raphael Parish, Father Armando Ibanez, O.P., has been reassigned to St. Finbar Parish in Burbank, CA. effective on July 1.

For three weekends, the Dominican Friar had his book, CD and DVD on sale after the Saturday-Sunday Masses (5:30, 7:30, 9:30 and 11) on June 15-16 with nearly \$2,500 in sales. The DVD documentary about the Katrina disaster, 'Not Broken,' sold out quickly at \$15 each.

His CD of his poetry, 'Poems of Stone and Bread' was next to sell out before the 11 a.m. Mass. His inventory of his book of poetry, 'Wrestling with the Angel' was almost sold out on Sunday, June 23. These sold for \$10 each. Retail prices were \$24.95, \$16.95 and \$19.95 respectively.

Father expressed, "I thank the parishioners for their support and appreciate immensely their generosity in purchasing these from me." He added, "The money from the sale will help me in my filmmaking work for Pluma Pictures, I founded in 2001. The production company is dedicated to producing films with inherent universal values, such as truth, peace, justice, beauty and the importance of family and community."




