
Rich's hobbies include gardening, reading, cycling, mathematical recreations, word puzzles and classical music.



Vincent Filippello Replaces Chris Arnoult As Financial Secretary of Council 5300

Vincent Lawrence Filippello, a member of the Knights of Columbus since December 13, 1999 has taken over the Financial Secretary position of Goleta Valley Council 5300. A St. Raphael parishioner for the past 30-years, Filippello replaces Christopher Arnoult who served for three years.

Some of his duties as Financial Secretary include collecting all moneys, billing procedures, keeping accounts, records and rolls and maintaining rosters.

Filippello recollected, "I retired in December 1998 and joined the Knights shortly thereafter. I was coming out of church one Sunday when I heard Frank Donohoe (with whom I worked with at Raytheon) talking to a mutual friend about the Knights. I listened and it sounded good so I told him I would join right there on the spot and I have not been disappointed since." PGK Donohoe became his sponsor.

Vince was born on February 11, 1938 to Jimmy and Helen Filippello in the small town of Amsterdam, N.Y., on the Mohawk River. Vince stated, "My dad was a butcher and my mom took care of me and my younger brother, Richard. Following the war, the whole family moved out West and settled in San Francisco. Our family arrived in April 1947 and were able to live within a block of all my uncles, aunts and grandmother." He added, "Saint Paul's Church was only two blocks away where I attended grammar school, became an Altar Boy and Boy Scout. After graduating from Saint Paul's, I attended Riordan High School where I was a member of the track team for all four years."

Shortly after graduating from high school in 1955, Vince decided to join the U.S. Army and was stationed at Fort Bliss, Texas where he was trained in maintenance of the Nike Ajax and Hercules anti-aircraft missile systems.

After being discharged he decided to go to college and study mechanical engineering, but had to work his way through. He stated, "So, it took me until 1967 to finally graduate from San Jose State University with a BSME."

"At SJSU is where I met the love of my life and wife Sandra Kaye Jones (born on Oct. 25, 1944 in Mt. Vernon, Illinois and was raised in Aberdeen, South Dakota) who graduated the same time with a teaching degree," beamed Vince. They were married in Saint Paul's Church on June 17, 1967 and lived in San Jose where he worked for Applied Technology Inc. and designed radar warning systems for combat aircraft. He attended SJSU evenings and earned his MSME in 1972.

They are proud parents of two grown children and five grandchildren. Son Ehren was born in 1969 and is now a school teacher in Oregon City, Oregon and daughter Jessica, born in 1973, is raising her two children, Cassidy, 10 and Sawyer, 4 in Denver, Colorado. Grandchildren, ages 4 to 13 include: Anthony 13, Connor 10, Carina 5, Cassidy 10, Sawyer 4.

Vince and Sandy left San Jose in 1978 and moved to Thousand Oaks where he worked for Hughes Missile System Division on the imaging infra red Maverick Missile. Then on to Bunker Ramo for three years. He noted, "I had been active in Little League, Cub Scouts and Boy Scouts in Thousand Oaks."

Vince joined Raytheon in Goleta in 1983 as Mechanical Engineering Department Manager. He had been attending California Lutheran University evenings for a number of years and earned his MBA in 1984.

Filippello has held the position as Advocate of the Knights. He stated the best thing about being a Knight is friendship and helping others.



The history of the Knights of Columbus, Goleta Valley Council 5300, goes back to 1961 when Walter Daniel Merrigan, Jr., served two years as Grand Knight. Merrigan became a Knight at age 18 in Las Vegas before moving to Santa Barbara and becoming the Grand Knight at age 32. 


