HHS mandate,

effective August 1, 2012, employees must provide contraception, abortifacients, and sterilization as part of their insurance packages or face the wrath of the federal government. The main target of the mandate was the Catholic Church. The U.S. Catholic bishops reacted with vigor, protesting the move, offering their own legal counteroffensive, and vowing to go to jail rather than allow the government to force them to violate Catholic moral doctrine.”

In a review of *Worshipping the State*: Many Christians feel that they are being opposed at every turn by what seems to be a well-orchestrated political and cultural campaign to de-Christianize every aspect of Western culture. They are right, and it goes even further than the Obama administration. Benjamin Wiker argues that it is liberals who seek to establish an official state religion : **ONE OF UNBELIEF**. Wiker reveals that it was never the intention of the Fopunders to drive religion out of the public square with the First Amendment, but centuries of secularists and liberals have deliberately misinterpreted the establishment clause to serve their own ends: *the de-Christianization of Western civilization*

WHEREAS, St. Aloyseius' Minor Seminary School is a Catholic private boarding school in Kitiwum, Cameroon, under the direction of Principal Father Zephyrinus Mbuh, dedicated to the higher education of children;

KC Parish Breakfasts, Blood Drives Successful Thanks to Many Knights

On Sunday, November 10, the Knights of Columbus, Council 5300 will be serving their delicious 'gourmet' breakfast and also coordinating a Blood Drive in the Parish Hall from 8:30 until 11 a.m.

Whether you attend the Sunday morning Masses or not, you can join us to enjoy scrambled eggs, sausage, pancakes, fruit juices, fruit cocktail, applesauce and coffee, tea or hot chocolate all for only \$5. Take out meals are also available.

When accompanied by one or both parents purchasing breakfast, children ages 12 and under will be treated to a free breakfast. Also all blood donors are given a free breakfast. Treasurer Joe Darga coordinates the Blood Donation Drive with United Blood Services, who are the beneficiaries of the blood donations. Blood Drives are held three times each year and always in conjunction with the Parish Breakfasts.

For the past 12 years Sir Knight James Bradbury has been coordinating the Knights volunteering their services in the kitchen. Jim does all the ordering and buying of supplies and is Chief Cook in the kitchen as well.

His helpers include Thomas Bauer, Jim Bonsell, Frank and Pat Donohoe, Bill Fuhrer, John McLafferty, Jose Mesa and John Peyton.

The Hall Hostess is Evelina Curzan. Paul Curzan sells the tickets and does the reporting on number of tickets sold and money collected. He also is responsible for submitting the Chair announcement requests each month for the Church Sunday Bulletin.

Bradbury recalls when the price was \$3 for the breakfast, then the price moved up a dollar and later rose to \$5 where it has remained for many years.

Proceeds are used to fund the charitable works of the Knights of Columbus, Council 5300. Curzan reported that 102 persons were served at the Sunday, October 13 Breakfast. This included 87 adult and 13 children along with several widows of deceased KC members. As a Council policy, widows are treated to a free breakfast. Ticket sales along with several donations resulted in \$440 being collected and turned over to Joe Darga, Council Treasurer.

As written by PGK Frank Donohoe in the St. Raphael Centennial Yearbook (1996), the Knights lead and help with many entertainment and social events such as the Oktoberfest dinner, St. Patrick's Day and Columbus Day dinner dances, Religious Appreciation Nights, hosting testimonial dinners honoring all priests, nuns, brothers and deacons of the deanery. They initiated the Parish Family Communion Pancake Breakfasts.

You can see that a continually evolving series of Knights and their families have and continue to devote time, effort and support to the many activities and needs of the Parish, Church, Community, Youth and the Council itself to fulfill the principles of the Knights of Columbus: Charity, Unity, Fraternity and Patriotism.
