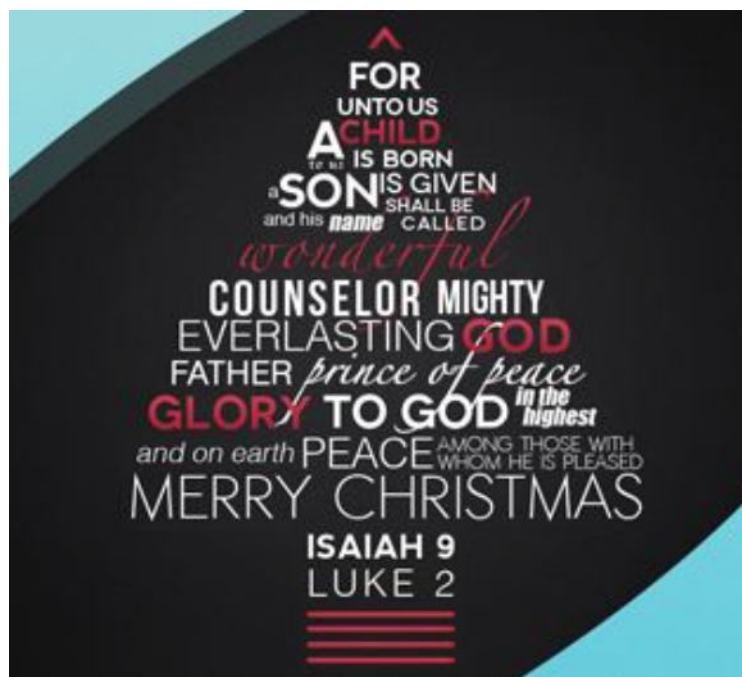

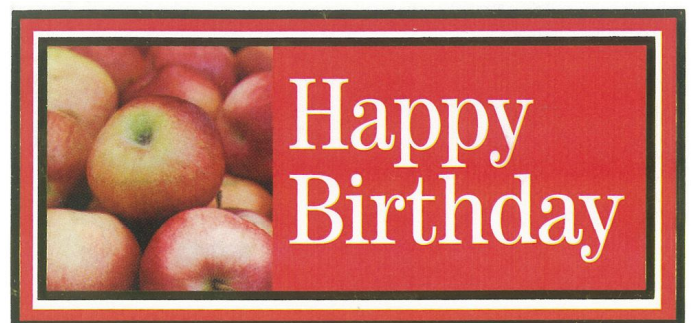

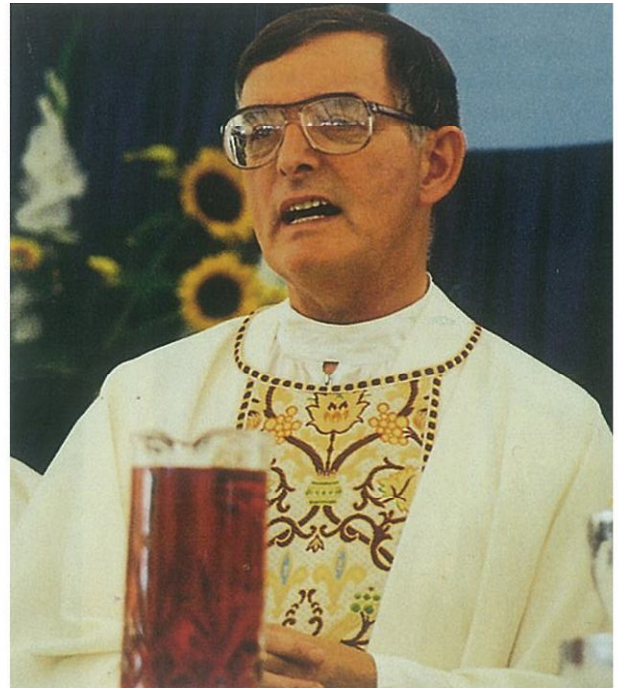

Jesse became a National Guardsman from 1957 - 1965, a Gardener at San Marcos High 1959 - 1967, and Santa Barbara County Fire Department 1967 - 1989, retired as a Captain because of a back injury at the age of 50 years old. JoAnn worked as a Certified Cosmetologist 1959 - 1964, and a Licensed Children's Daycare provider for 25 years. Jesse became a Knight of Columbus October 1, 1980 with 1684 Santa Barbara transferred to Goleta Valley in 1987, Grand Knight 1993 - 1994, and 4th Degree in 1993 and was Faithful Navigator 1999 - 2000 with the Junipero Serra Assembly and member of the Color Corp. In 2002 Jesse, JoAnn and son Joe moved to the Orcutt/Santa Maria area. Jesse and JoAnn are basically retired except JoAnn is selling Avon products. 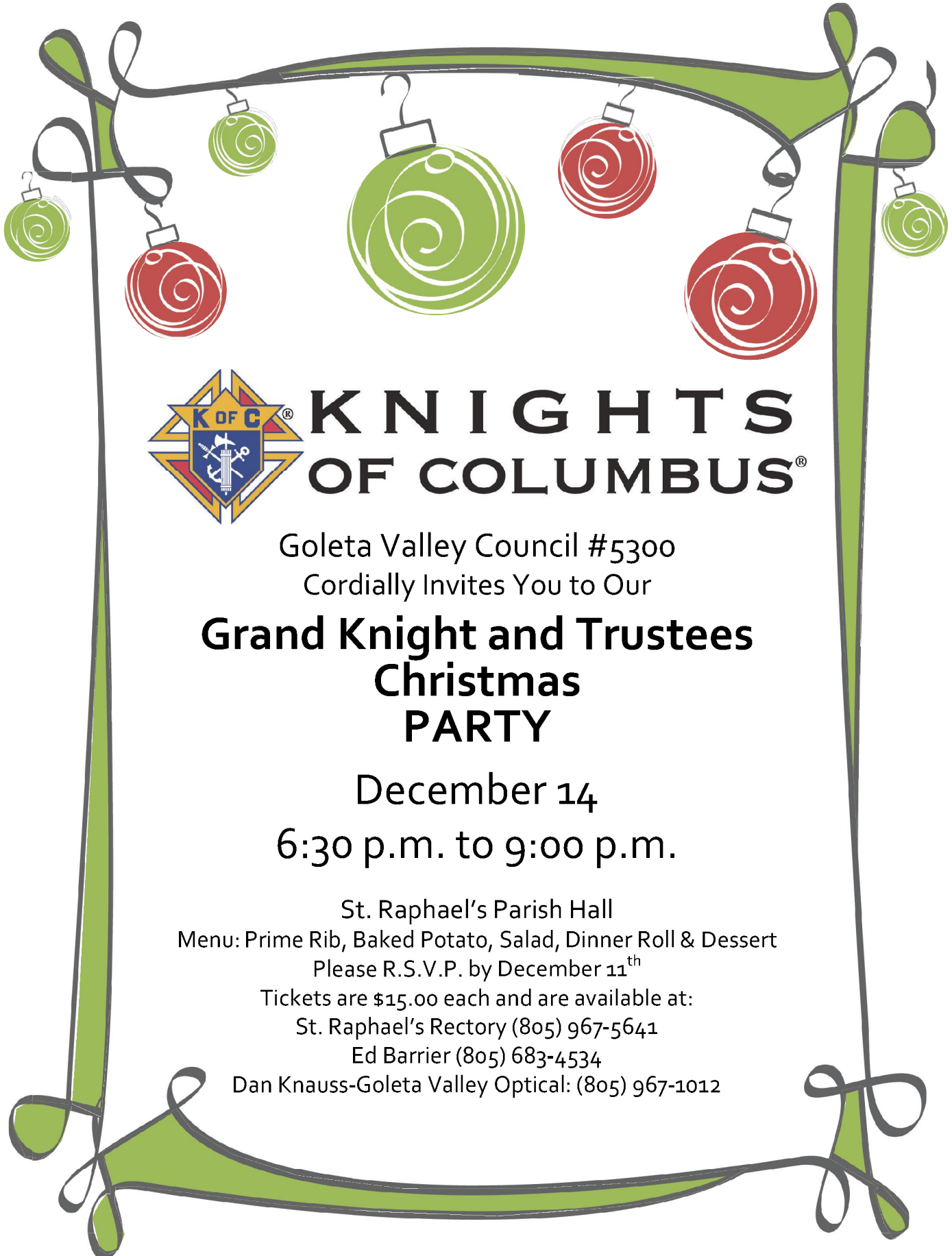
