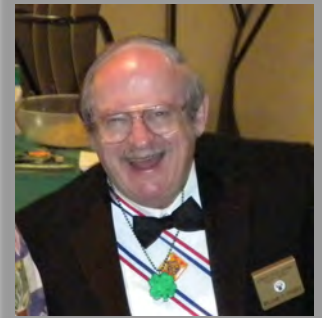

In Loving Memory of
Joseph Roman Meitz

June 5, 1923 - January 8, 2014



On January 8, 2014, Joseph Roman Meitz returned home to the Lord at the age of 90.

Joe was born in Milwaukee, Wisconsin on June 5, 1923 to Charles and Katherine Meitz. While in high school, he met the love of his life, Audrey Fleischmann, and the two were married on Oct. 26, 1946, remaining inseparable for over 67-years.

At the age of 19, he enlisted in the U.S. Army Air Corps, serving for three years with the 379th Bomb group, 527th Squadron stationed in Kimbolton, England. As a radio operator and gunner on the Carol-Dawn, a B-17 flying fortress, he flew 32 missions and was awarded the Distinguished Flying Cross for his service.

After leaving the military, he spent 35-years with General Motors, transferring from Milwaukee to Santa Barbara in 1972 with Delco Electronics, from which he retired as Chief Draftsman in 1983.

In retirement Joe was highly active in community organizations such as the Knights of Columbus (40-years), and St. Raphael's Parish since 1972 and the Elks Lodge (40-years). Joe served as an Extraordinary Minister for 10-years and ushering at Mass for many years. He joined the Knights of Columbus, Council 5300 on February 11, 1974, and had many fond memories of many events the Knights

sponsored, especially the Special Olympics, which he ran for six years. He also built toys for children. Many Knights participated to assist the 300 to 400 Special Olympians involved in all the field events including wheelchair races. Joe's greatest personal moment as a Knight was delivering Christmas food on Christmas Eve to Poor Families in the community.

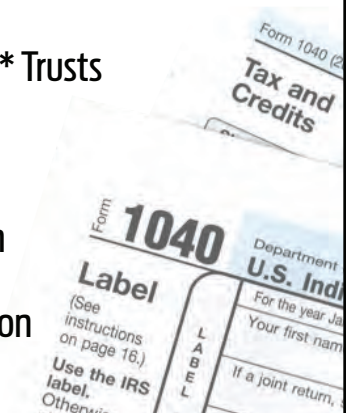
In addition to his work in the community, Joe enjoyed traveling, spending time with family and watching his beloved Green Bay Packers play football. Joe is survived by his wife Audrey, his eight children: Robert, Phillip, James, Mary Jo, William, Barbara, Jeanne and David; his 16 grandchildren, eight great-grandchildren and one great-great-grandchild. A Memorial Service for Joe was held at St. Raphael's Church on Monday, Jan. 13 at 10 a.m., with Rev. James Seiwert, celebrant.

Joseph Ronald Darga was born on February 11, 1934 in Detroit, Michigan. Joe's parents, Joseph and Hattie, were proud of Joe and Connie, daughter.

Karen Jean Mammen, Joe's wife, is a native of Chicago. They first met while working for the Burroughs Corp. in Goleta. Their wedding took place in Holy Family Church in South Pasadena.

Joe and Karen are proud parents of David Scott, Cheryl Dylan and Paul Allen and also proud grandparents of Ryan, Megan, Curtis, Dylan and Justin.

At age 22 Joe joined the U.S. Navy and served from 1956-58 as an Aviation Electron Tech - 2nd Class.

Joe and Karen have been parishioners of St. Raphael since 1970. Joe became a Knights of Columbus member on July 14, 1999 and now is serving as Treasurer of Council 5300. His sponsor was Jesse Garcia.

Joe worked for 22 years at Burroughs and when that firm left Goleta, he joined Santa Barbara Research Center for 14 years. Joe retired in 1995 due to medical, heart problems. A-Cross America Relay for Pro-Life

March 5 – April 13, 2014

The National LIFE Runners Team is planning the second annual A-Cross America Relay for Pro-Life, to be run during Lent 2014. On Ash Wednesday, March 5, the East coast arm (1,997 miles) launches from the Brooklyn Bridge in New York City, and the West coast arm (2,092 miles) launches from the Golden Gate Bridge in San Francisco. The route passes through CA, CO, DC, IA, IL, IN, MD, MO, NE, NJ, NV, NY, OH, PA, SD, UT, WV, WY, and near KY, ID, and MN. After 40 days and 1,103 legs (~5K each) covering 4,089 miles, the East coast and West coast arms will unite at St. Joseph Cathedral in Sioux Falls, S.D., on Palm Sunday, April 13. The mission of the LIFE Runners is to pray, fund-raise, and run/walk as a team — *All in Christ for Pro-Life*.

In addition to encouraging individuals to sign up to run legs at liferunners.org/across as the relay passes through their area, the LIFE Runners Team needs the help of SECTION LEADERS along the relay route to contact others and ensure that every leg of a state/region is filled.

1. Sign-up for a section of legs in your area (10+) and then contact others to ensure we fill every single leg in your area.
2. Work with other LIFE Runners chapter leaders and runners in your state to coordinate the sections you will each take, ensuring coverage from one side of the state to the other.
3. Organize or encourage groups of 5-10 runners to take vans/vehicles to remote areas for a team-building, social and pro-life pilgrimage, alternating runners to cover more distance.
4. Contact churches, diocesan respect life offices, Knights of Columbus councils, 40 Days for Life groups, Christian schools and universities, and other pro-life organizations in your region.
