Grand Knight's Report

From William Fuhrer, Our Grand Knight



Did Pope Francis really say that?

We need to come out of ourselves, from a tired and apathetic way of living faith, from the temptation of closing ourselves in our own schemes that ultimately close the horizon of God's creative action. God came out of himself to come among us. He pitched his tent among us through his mercy that saves us and gives us hope. If we wish to follow him and remain in him, we should not be content with remaining in with the ninety nine sheep. We ought "to go out," to search with him for the lost sheep, the one who is most distant. Remember well: come out of yourselves, like Jesus, like God came out of himself in Jesus, and Jesus came out of himself for us all.

How I wish that the Lord would make us understand and feel that evangelization "is not an optional contribution for the Church. It is the duty incumbent on her by the command of the Lord Jesus, so that people can be believed and saved. This message is indeed necessary. It is unique. It cannot be replaced. It does not permit either indifference, syncretism, or accommodation. It is a question of people's salvation. It is the beauty of the revelation that it represents. It brings with it a wisdom that is not of this world. It is to stir up by itself faith-faith that rests on the power of God" (Paul VI Evangelii Nuntiandi, no 5)

We do not have the right to be indifferent and to love ourselves. How I love myself! No we do not have that right. We need to go out and proclaim that 2000 years ago, there was a man who wanted to reestablish the earthly paradise, and he came for that reason. To restore all things.

We need to come out of our shells and tell others that Jesus lives, that Jesus lives for him, for her, and to tell them this with joy...even though at times seem crazy. Saint Paul says that the message of the Gospel is foolishness. Our lifetime is not enough to surrender and announce this: that Jesus has restored life. We have to go to sow hope: we have to go into the streets. We have to go out to search

The first thing the Virgin Mary did when she received the Good News in her womb was to go out running to be of service. Let us go running out to be of service, in that we believe the Good News of Christ yesterday, today and always.

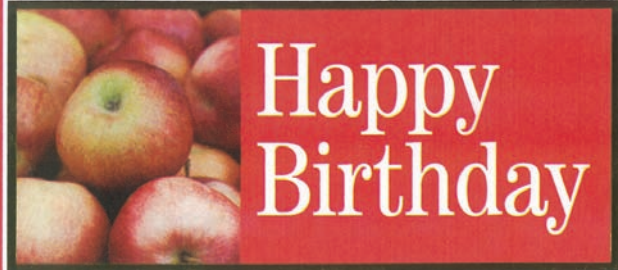


A picture from the recent Mother's Day Vigil at Planned Parenthood with 30 people attending.

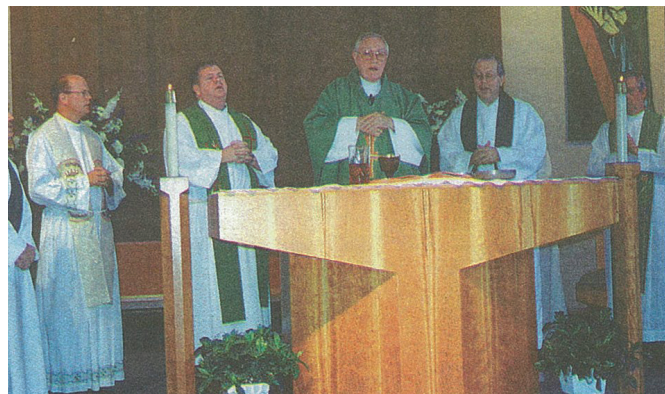
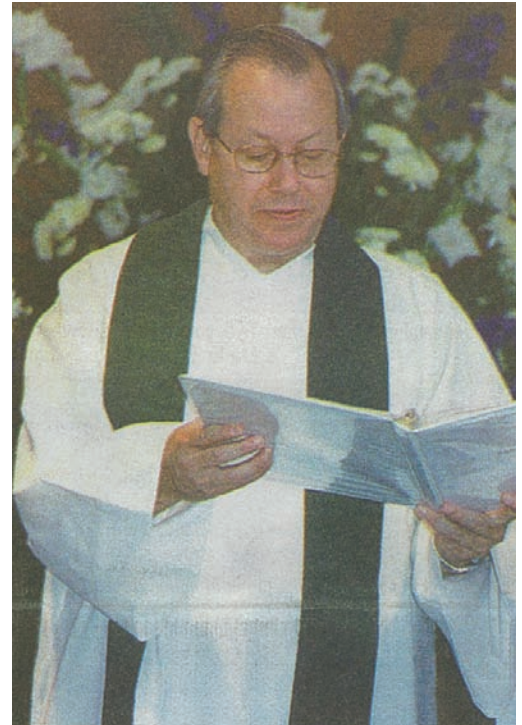
Fr. Bruce has been Pastor of St. Raphael Parish since July 1, 2002. He will finish his 12-year term as Pastor here on June 30 and will be starting a new pastorate at San Roque Parish (our neighboring parish) on July 1.

According to Noel Fuentes, Pastoral Associate, heads of each parish organization or ministry are bringing some desserts with a lemon theme...as Father Bruce likes lemon! Knights of Columbus is asked to be in charge of Lemonade and water only. Other groups will be bringing cupcakes, Bundt cakes, lemon cake, lemon cookies, lemon ice cream, cups, napkins, plates.

Father was ordained for the Archdiocese of Los Angeles in 1985 after graduating from St. John's Seminary in Camarillo. Fr. Bruce was born in Rhode Island and raised all around Central and Southern California. He is the youngest of three children. His brother Ray is an attorney in private practice and a former Worker's Compensation Judge. His sister Debbie is a retired Deputy Sheriff.

A few years ago in a TIDINGS interview, Fr. Bruce shared the following about St. Raphael Parish. "St. Raphael parish is filled with welcoming and committed people. They tend to be flexible and, with a variety of priests coming and going in their lives, patient and willing to hear different ideas. They have supported building drives and kept the parish in wonderful condition. Most everything is done by volunteers. Most importantly, their commitment to faith underline everything. I have found in them a desire to grow and learn."

Father Bruce, thank you for saying YES to God and your daily YES in helping us, your flock of 4,100 parishioners, know God more and more!
