

# James Bradbury Now Serving as 53rd Grand Knight

James Howard Bradbury has assumed the Grand Knight leadership of the Knights of Columbus, Goleta Valley Council 5300, serving for the 2014-15 Columbian year. Bro. Jim is the 53rd Grand Knight in the 54-year history of the Council.

The native of Santa Barbara became a Knight on June 11, 2001, a 2nd Degree on Sept. 6, 2001, a 3rd Degree on Sept. 23, 2001 and a 4th Degree on Nov. 2, 2002. His sponsors were Paul Curzan and Sam Alfano.

Bro. Jim was installed as Grand Knight in an installation ceremony on Saturday, June 21 at Serra Hall in a joint installation with Council 1684. District Deputy Ray Centeno performed the impressive rites as all other new officers also were installed.

The 69-year Bradbury acclaimed, "I decided to become a KC member after working all my life so in retirement I wanted to give back to the community through a Christian organization."

Bro. Jim stated, "The best thing about being a KC member is doing my small part in helping to raise funds for the Knight's charities." He added, "Doing the breakfasts once a month for the past 13 years stands out as cherished remembrances never to be forgotten. I do most of all the cooking for the 3rd and 4th Degree functions and also put up and take down the Coke booth for Fiesta."

In the past four years in the Council, Jim has served also as Warden in 2011-12, 4th Degree Pilot 2009, Navigator 2011 and Admiral 2012 and Deputy Grand Knight 2012-13.

Bradbury's recommendations why other men should consider becoming a member of the Knights of Columbus are "To join a men's Christian organization to deepen their faith to take that feeling home to their families and community and feel the satisfaction of helping others."

Two of Jim's goals for the 2014-15 Columbian year include:

1). making the Christian community aware of all the wonderful Charitable things the Knights do for different organizations;

2). getting my fellow brothers to more volunteering.

Jim was born on April 21, 1945 in Santa Barbara. His father Howard was born in Santa Barbara while mother Myrtle was from Missouri. His parents were proud of Jim and his two sisters, Judy Wolford and Jean Todd (deceased).

Jim graduated from Roosevelt Elementary in 1959, San Marcos High School in 1963 and earned an aeronautical degree and A&P license from Miramar.

Jim joined the U.S. Navy in 1966 and served in Viet Nam and stateside as an aircraft mechanic until his discharge in 1969.

Bradbury has worked as a car mechanic, aircraft mechanic and delivered United Parcel for 25-years until retirement. He said, "Hard work, dedication and commitment were keys to his success in his professional career. Jim's special community involvements include working the voting booths and being President of the Meadowlark Road Association.

On May 14, 1966 Jim married Diane Marie Stoyka at St. Raphael Church with Father John G. Fitzgerald as celebrant (served at the parish from 1962-67 and is now a retired Monsignor.) Jim and Diane met in Study Hall at San Marcos High School when Diane was 15 and Jim was 16 and they have been Happy Together ever since!




