## Pro-Life Report for November 2014

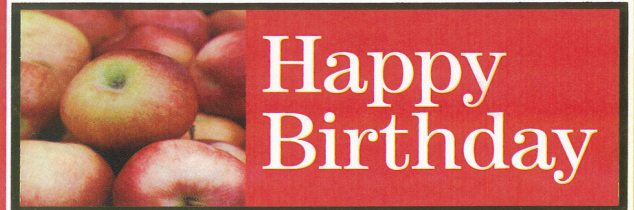

## Pictorial Coverage of Installation of Msgr. Jon as Pastor

Thanks to Noel Fuentes, Pastoral Associate, and to Evelyn Pasos, St. Raphael School 6th grader, who took these colorful photos, Knightline readers will recollect the historic ceremony with Msgr. Jon Majarucon's installation of Pastor on Sunday, Sept. 28. The special Mass was concelebrated by Msgr. Michael Jennett, Msgr. Jon and Father Remmy Kimbowa and assisted by Deacons Wayne Rascati, Stephen Montross and Vince from Santa Clara Church in Oxnard.

The Installation of Pastor took place after the Gospel, the pastor-elect stands before the Episcopal Vicar and is presented to him.

Noel: Msgr. Jennett, after consultations with the clergy and laity of the Diocese, you have chosen the Reverend Monsignor Jon Majarucon as the new pastor of this parish.

Msgr. Jennett: My dear friends, because I am aware of your pastoral needs and am confident of Msgr. Jon's qualifications of the Office of Pastor, I now entrust to him the Pastorate of this parish. I invite you to welcome him with your applause.

Msgr. Jennett's homily on the office of pastor followed.

Noel then introduced members of the parish community who came forward and presented Msgr. Jennett with symbols of his pastoral office. The items are placed on a table near the baptistery.

\* **Carried by Charles Kriech** - Noel: The Lectionary. This is our Lectionary, may it be a reminder to you of Our prayer that you will always be a faithful preacher of God's Word in our midst.

\* **Carried by John Vasellina** - Noel: The Holy Oils. With this Holy Chrism you will anoint those you have Welcomed into the church through the sacraments of initiation; may they come to know of the Lord's love through your Ministry to them.

\* **Carried by Mary Lac** - Noel: May this oil of the sick remind you that as our Pastor you must have a constant concern for the sick, the aged and the lonely; may your presence bring them comfort and hope.

\* **Carried by Melissa Colborn** - Noel: May the oil of the Catechumen remind us that all are welcomed to become part of the Family of God to share in God's divine life.

\* **Carried by Maureen Espinoza** - Noel: The Eucharistic Vessels. May these vessels be signs of our constant desire that you feed us with the Bread of Life and the Cup of Salvation at the Table of the Lord's Sacrifice.

\* **Carried by Pat Pigatti** - Noel: The Rite of Penance. This is our parish book for the Celebration of the Sacrament of Penance. Through the Sacrament you are to reconcile sinners to God and to the Church. May you always be a gentle and loving father to all who seek forgiveness through your ministry.

Profession of Faith and Oath:

Msgr. Jennett: Remember, my brother Jon, always be a loving Father, a gentle shepherd, and a wise teacher of your people, so that you may lead them to Christ who will strengthen all that you do. As a teacher of that faith, I ask you to now lead your people in the profession of their faith.

## Father Remmy Kimbowa Enjoys Short Visit While Serving St. Raphael Parish When Our Priests Are on Their Vacation

During the month of October, Father Remmy Kimbowa from Mityana, Uganda in East Africa visited St. Raphael's Parish to cover Father Lucia Juarez and Pastor Msgr. Jon Majarucon while on vacation.

The 31-year old priest was ordained on July 16, 2011, Kiyinda Mityana Diocese in the parish of Busuubizi in Uganda. He is one of 15 children born to Resty and Joseph Kimbowa.

Ten sisters, four brothers and his parents are proud of what he has done in three years.

Since ordination Fr. Remmy has served as Private Secretary to the Bishop and also in charge of two Mission Churches. He stated, "As a priest in Uganda I work not only as a priest but also a doctor, lawyer, farmer, everything."

Father added, "I love my assignment as the Bishop's Secretary because I get to reach all the corners of the Diocese with my Bishop helping and ministering to people."

"The people at St. Raphael are very friendly and welcoming," said Fr. Remmy. "The priests, deacons and rectory staff are the best people to work with," added Fr.

Father first wanted to become a priest at age 8 after admiring the good job the Sisters were doing for the poor people. He joined the Minor Seminary when he was 14 years old in 1997. He enjoyed life as a Seminarian and now three years as a priest.
