





Al stated, "The late Emma Kunze gave us the pine greens for many years and son Herb has supplied the hay for the manger since the beginning. Pastor Edward Hempfling originally wanted a full manger setting with all the animals and other statues, but space prevented that in 1961 in the old church. Today little children leave personal messages to Jesus at the manger. The beautiful setting will remain in the Church from December 15 through Sunday, January 11 according to Al. Special thanks go to Al and his helpers who do this special work of beauty each Christmas season.




