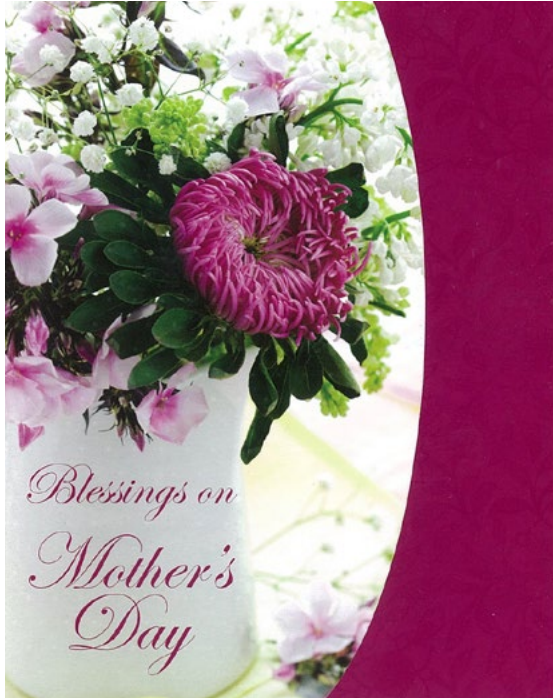

Memorial Day Picnic at Tucker's Grove, Special Feature on Padre Serra in KC Magazine

By the time this article comes out, the 3rd Degree Exemplification will be over. We have approximately 51 candidates and about 120 people coming to the dinner, which is a very good turnout. I have to apologize to any of the old Knights because I had informed everyone that this was the first time that Council 5300 had put a 3rd Degree on. I have been mistaken and will correct myself to say the last time it was put on in the Goleta Council 5300 was in 1982. So I apologize to those that do remember that far back.

Please don't forget that we are going to have a Memorial Day Picnic on May 25th at Tuckers Grove in Kiwanis meadows. The menu sounds great. It will be tri tip with brats and all of the trimmings. So please attend. I will be inviting the parish to this event.

In the April Columbia magazine there is an article on Father Junipero Serra who will be canonized in September of this year by Pope Francis. Father Serra was born in 1713. He was raised in the village of Petra on the Spanish island of Mallorca. At the age of 18, he joined the Franciscan Order and took the name of Junipero, after one of the first companions of St Francis of Assisi. At the age of 35, Father Serra got permission to become a missionary and came to Mexico. During his time as a missionary, Father Serra tried to improve the living conditions of the Indians by introducing farming crafts and trades. Father Serra also protested the treatment of Indians from the Spanish soldiers at that time. He tried his hardest to protect the Indians. In 1769 Father Serra arrived in the town of San Diego and started building his first mission in Alta, California. For the remaining 15 years of his life, he continued to live out the motive "always forward never back." Between the years 1769 and 1782, Father Serra established the first 9 of 21 eventual California missions. In 1784 Father Serra passed away at the Mission San Carlos. On a side note, my wife and I have been to Washington, DC and have seen the statue of Father Junipero Serra in the rotunda. After reading several articles on Father Serra, I feel that he should be canonized. He was a very holy man, and did much for the Indians and spread Christianity throughout California by establishing the missions.

Jim will be lovingly remembered by many friends and family, including his wife Lynne, his children Denis (Andrea), Pat (PJ) and Brian (Quynh) and grandchildren,

Travis (Tabatha), Tyler, Brittany, Katie and Shane.

Jim was born September 25, 1934 in Rochester, New York, the son of James Jerome and Mary Agnes Shooter. He attended Glenclyffe Seminary where he pursued Philosophy and Religious Studies earning a Bachelor's of Arts Degree in 1955.

He joined the U.S. Air Force and served as an Airman Second Class from May 1, 1956 through April 30, 1960. He met the love of his life, Lynne Schultz at a dance club for Catholic singles in Orlando, Florida and they married on March 30, 1959. The newlyweds were stationed in Albuquerque, New Mexico.

After Jim completed his time in the Air Force, he accepted a job with IBM in Goleta, CA., as a Field Engineer.

In 1962 Jim and Lynne settled into life in their new home in Goleta and began raising their family. They were devoted members of St. Raphael's Church. Jim shared his love of the Lord by teaching CCD classes at the church and sang in the choir for many years. Jim became a 4th Degree Knights of Columbus Honorary Life Member on April 12, 1988. He became a Council 5300 member on Feb. 10, 1975, a 2nd Degree on March 10, 1975 and 3rd Degree on June 1, 1975. His sponsor was Roy Schrader.

An avid amateur ham radio operator with the call sign WA6SJC, Jim always had an ear to the ground and knew everything that was going on in his neighborhood. Jim also served as volunteer at Goleta Valley Cottage Hospital.

After Jim's retirement from IBM, Jim and Lynne enjoyed traveling around the USA in their RV visiting friends and family and enjoying the outdoor lifestyle.

Roy Kai Fong was born on May 18, 1924 in Los Angeles, California. Soon after receiving his AA Degree in LA City College, Roy would join the U.S. Air Force at age 19.

His parents, Edward F. and Cane Lee, were proud when he served as a Radio Operator in Wisconsin and graduated in Control Network System and was assigned to 474th Fighter Group, 430th Squadron. He would serve in the European Theatre to direct pilots how to return safely to their base. The pilots would call Roy for homing instructions and Roy would give them bearing instructions to come home.

Roy and Elizabeth (Liz) Joan Hall first met in Los Angeles and were married on December 8, 1979 at St. Brendan Church. They moved to Santa Barbara in 1981 and became very active with St. Raphael Church until 2007. They now reside in Foster City and attend St. Luke's Church.

After his military service Roy would work as Sr. Electrical Draftsman for the Los Angeles Department of Water & Power for 30+ years. For 10 years Roy worked at UCSB's Facility Management as Electrical Engineer, retiring in 1990.

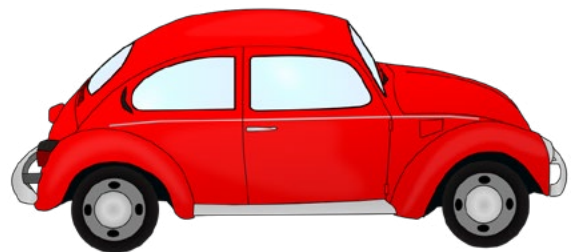
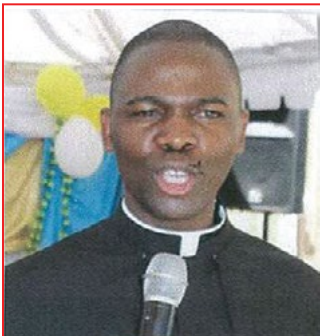
Liz stated, "I love classical music and used to play the piano, but now my fingers don't cooperate any more."
