Knight, Parishioner Write Letters to the Editor, News-Press

Twenty years ago Judge Robert Bork wrote Slouching Toward Gomorrah, detailing evidence of our nation's moral decay as it embraces liberalism. How prophetic!

We mourn the loss of young UCSB students killed in the I.V. Massacre, each person of infinite value, each life prematurely ended. Memorials. Gardens. Awards for valor to the responders; a community embraces families still suffering. Joining the mourners, we ask "How could this happen?" Partial answer: runaway individualism, each one doing "whatever feels right." Conflicting behavior emerges from our culture's moral confusion on valuing life. We condemn the I. V. massacre - and rightly so. But our eyes have blinders, for every day, week, month, 42 years: the slaughter of innocent unborn children continues - over 50 million and counting in the USA. Here in our city at Planned Parenthood young girls abort their babies, often without parents' knowledge. Where is our outrage? Why are advocates for the unborn - who pray against the Massacre by Abortion - condemned, mocked, given the finger by passersby on Garden Street?

From I.V. to Garden Street: a great inconsistency in valuing human life: where are the mourners and responders? Do we pick and choose which killings to protect, which killings to protest? TURMOIL REIGNS REGARDING THE TRUE VALUE OF LIFE: PHYSICIANS LEGALLY KILL UNBORN BABIES IN ONE MASSACRE; LAWS ARE DEVELOPING SO PHYSICIANS CAN ASSIST AT SUICIDES IN ANOTHER MASSACRE. THE SLIPPERY SLOPE BECOMES AN ICE SHEET: SOCIETY CONTINUES ITS FREEFALL INTO DISASTER.

COMPLETE ANSWER: DESTROYING OUR GODLY FOUNDATIONS.

Why Fund Planned Parenthood?

According to the non-partisan GAO, federal funding for the Planned Parenthood Organization recorded over the period 2010-2012 was \$1.5 billion. And, according to Planned Parenthood's own budget report for fiscal 2013-2014, its net assets were \$1.4 billion. A good portion of federal funding, i.e., taxpayer money, is spent not only abortion, but supplying women and young girls with anti-reproductive meds.




