## Pro-Life Report for July 2015

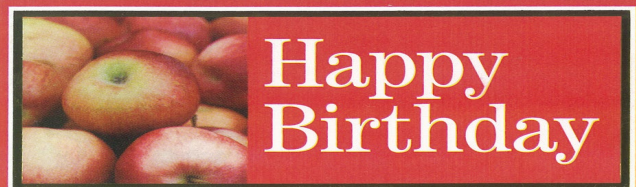
The Knights of Columbus is a very strong Pro-Life organization, actively engaged to save the lives of unborn children from abortion.

## John C. Kirk Jr. Now Serving as 54th Grand Knight

John Clay Kirk Jr. has assumed the Grand Knight leadership of the Knights of Columbus Goleta Valley Council 5300, serving for the 2015-16 Columbian year. Brother John is the 54th Grand Knight in the 55-year history of the Council.

The native of Philadelphia, PA. became a Knight in November 1966, a 2nd and 3rd Degree in 1970 and a 4th Degree on April 28, 1990.

Brother John was installed as Grand Knight in an Installation Ceremony at Serra Hall in a joint installation with Council 1684. District Deputy Ray Centeno performed the impressive rites as all other officers also were installed. Please see page 15 for the names of the officers and directors selected and appointments to various committees.

The 76-year old Kirk's recommendations why other men should consider being a member of Council 5300 were stated, "We are the men's club of the Catholic Church. Pope John Paul II called us his strong arm. I can't think of a better way to assist the Pope with his new evangelization then as a Knight, being his strong arm."

Three of John's goals for the 2015-16 Columbian year include:

- 1). We need to increase our membership, engage those Knights who are currently inactive yet capable of participating in council meetings and activities;
- 2). I would also like to see if we can get a Squires program going, that works with the Boy Scouts and Youth Group, to get them thinking Knights of Columbus;
- 3). I would also like to see what we can do to increase the participation of the young Alter Servers at Mass.

For the past several years John has served as the Pro-Life Director and in 2014-15 was the Deputy Grand Knight. In his years in Baltimore he was responsible for mailing out the KC bulletin.

John was born on October 1, 1938 in Philadelphia. His parents, John C. Kirk Sr., and mother Catherine Fitzpatrick were proud parents of two boys and five girls. His sisters include Mary Ann,

John attended St. Francis of Assisi Grade School in Philadelphia and a graduate of Sacred Heart in Salisbury, N.C. He earned a BSEE from North Carolina State in Raleigh and an MSEE from Marquette.

John served in the U.S. Air Force from 1956-58. He did radar and electronic countermeasures repair on the B-52 as part of SAC.

John is the proud parent of two sons, John F., who lives in Texas and Kevin, who lives in Ohio and a daughter, Heather, residing in Los Angeles and also five grandchildren.

In 1973 John moved from Baltimore, MD to work at Raytheon in Goleta for six years. He stated, "I am still working and enjoy my work. I have been in business for myself since 1979."

John remarked, "The best things about being a parishioner at St. Raphael are going to Mass for 42-years now, my kids attending St. Raphael Grade School and Bishop Diego High School and enjoying the simplicity of our church design, especially the large Crucifix, our Tabernacle and our Altar." He continued, "I have been a Lector for about 30-years and a Eucharistic Minister for about 15 years, many of those years as a Minister to the Sick."

John added, "The keys to my successful professional career have been luck or the Grace of God."

Priests who have been extra-special to him during his years at St. Raphael include Father Henry Van Son (was a very special priest) and Father Eugene Flaherty. Both were very helpful during difficult times. Wonderful men."

John's community involvements were spotlighted when he coached 15 youth soccer teams when his kids where in grade school for the Goleta Boys Club and Goleta Girls Club.

## Deacon Wayne M. Rascati Marks 20th Anniversary As a Permanent Deacon at St. Raphael on June 10

Deacon Wayne Michael Rascati celebrated his 20th Anniversary as a Permanent Deacon at St. Raphael Parish. A member of St. Raphael Church for the past 51-years, he was ordained with 18 classmates on June 10, 1995, by Cardinal Archbishop Roger Mahony at Blessed Sacrament Church in Hollywood.

Deacon Wayne was selected one of two representatives to assist at the Altar during the Ordination Mass. Witnessing this ordination in a filled church of 1,200 persons were a busload of St. Raphael parishioners, his father Frank, brother Randall, sisters Kirsten Rascati Franzen, Shelagh Grimm, niece Kellie Greene and relatives from out-of-state. Watching from Heaven were his mother Mariam Donahue Rascati, a sister Noel, and brother William, deceased.

On Sunday, June 11, 1995 Deacon Wayne gave his first Homily at the 9:30 Mass. At the reception after Mass held in the new Parish Hall, parishioners extended congratulatory wishes to Deacon Wayne. Grand Knight Ygnacio Ramirez presented Deacon Wayne with a gift from the Knights of Columbus, a green Deacon stole. The Knights and the Women's Auxiliary co-sponsored the reception.

A Saturday night (June 10th) dinner for family, out of town guests, parish staff and friends was made possible by Ralph and Cathy Wengler, Felix and Julie Sanchez, Tom and Joann Quinn, Millie Bertuzzi and some of our Boy Scouts. Wayne attributes his vocation to the work of Deacon Tony and Rosemary Varesio and Deacon Robert Ruggerio (formerly of San Roque; now of Reno). They along with Msgr. Stephen Downes helped me recognize the call of the Holy Spirit to this wonderful ministry of service," he said.

Deacon Wayne is the fourth Permanent Deacon ordained from this Parish. Previously ordained were Deacons A. J. (Tony) Varesio (1975), Virgil Glocheski (1979) and Clarke Shea (1982). Deacon Steve Montross was ordained in 2007 and Sergio Lopez is our Deacon candidate currently in formation. "We pray for the continued guidance of the Holy Spirit in the life, service and ministry of Deacon Wayne and all deacons who serve in our Church," stated Msgr. Jon Majarucon.

Born on July 3, 1947 in Newark, New Jersey, Wayne and his parents with brothers and sisters moved to Goleta in 1964. Wayne was baptized in Sacred Heart Cathedral in Newark, N.J. and confirmed in St. Hedwig's Church in Elizabeth, N.J. His mother Mariam died in August 1988, his father died in March 1987; brother William in 1946 and sister Noel in 1977.

While attending UC Santa Barbara (1969 graduate) he took an interest in writing and editing publications. He was involved with the daily newspaper, yearbook, radio station and orientation handbook. He was part of the dedication of the Thomas M. Storke Building. He remembers escorting Tom Storke to the top of the 188' Tower during construction just before they removed the scaffolding.

He kept this up as he wrote a regular column in the SPIRIT parish newspaper, titled "Servant's Corner." His first was "Outreach to Others in Justice and Love." Deacon Wayne's personal goal is "To live one's life to the fullest from

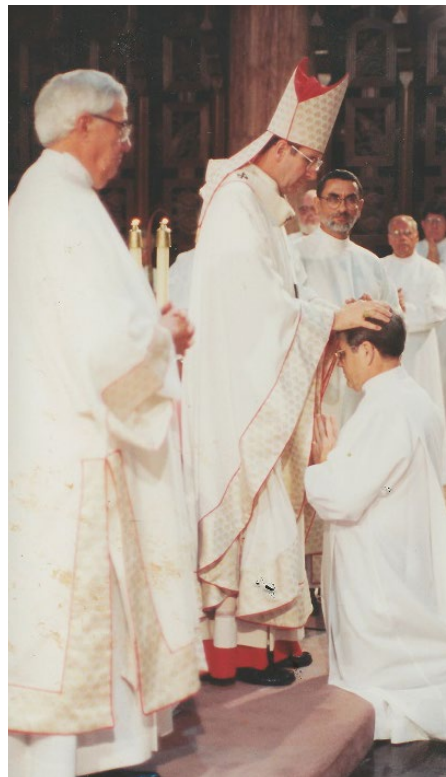
our inner being.” His favorite quotation is “Service is the rent we pay for our room on earth.” (unknown author). “This service that you perform is not only supplying the needs of God’s people but is also overflowing in many expressions of thanks to God.” (2 Corinthians 9 12).

Always wanting to help someone in need, Wayne found the Boy Scouts to be an outstanding program. In February 1995 Deacon Wayne was recognized by the Archdiocesan Catholic Committee in Scouting with the St. George Emblem for work in the Scouting program. In 1994 he was appointed Chaplain for Troop 105.

Wayne worked for the U.S. Postal Service starting in June 1967. He was a manager from September 1974 until his retirement in 2002. Between 1982 and 1990 he served as National Vice President for the National Association of Postal Supervisors. He was instrumental in the plans to move the Processing and Distribution Center to the new facility on Storke Road in 1996. From July 2002 until August 2007 he was Business Manager of St. Raphael’s Church. Since that date he has been an instructor for special education students and substitute teacher in the Goleta School District.

Wayne became a member of the Knights of Columbus Council 5300 on August 8, 1983 after being approached by Don Aubrey, a 2nd Degree on September 30, 1983, a 3rd Degree on November 19, 1983, and a 4th Degree on November 3, 1984. With his expertise in publications, he soon became Editor of the Knightline, serving for several years. He was also Faithful Navigator of Junipero Serra Assembly during 1989 and 1990

Over the years his hobbies have included stamp collecting, computers, spending the day with his niece and now nephews Ryan and Christian, traveling, reading and following his favorite sports teams include the Dodgers (he goes back to Brooklyn as a loyal fan), 49ers, Seahawks and the Washington Capitols.

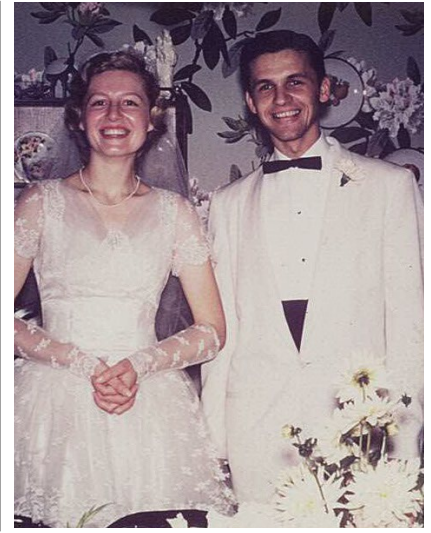

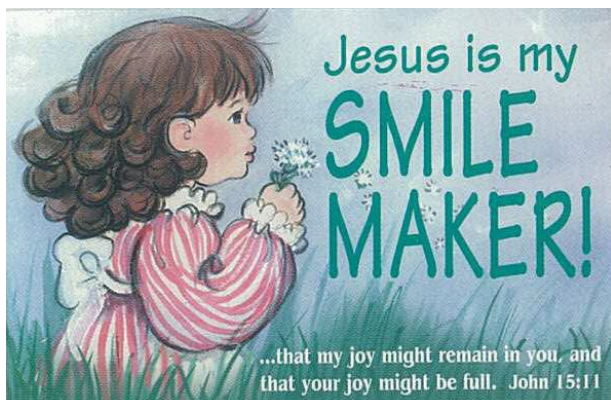
