### RESOLUTION

Knights of Columbus Goleta Valley Council 5300

WHEREAS There are requests for charitable support in excess of our ability to finance from current income.

THEREFORE be it resolved that the officers transfer \$30,000 from the Building Fund to the Charitable Account to cover this shortfall.

Written, approved and signed by Deacon Wayne Rascati, Past Financial Secretary, Michael Donovan, Past Grand Knight and Solomon Sanchez, Past Grand Knight.

At the Business Meeting of Council 5300 on 10/12/15 the 2015-16 budget as amended was discussed on the floor. The original budget had been approved by vote of the council on 8/10/15. Amounts donated were modified and approved at the officers meeting on 10/5/15, believing this was adequate to cover the budget approval. At the 10/12 meeting several members professed that each withdrawal from the Building Fund must be approved by an individual resolution passed by the membership. Thus the above Resolution was written, and will be voted on at the 11/9/15 Business Meeting.

ALL MEMBERS ARE ENCOURAGED TO ATTEND THIS MEETING, JOIN IN ANY FURTHER DISCUSSION, AND CAST YOUR VOTE TO ACCEPT A BUDGET. IT'S YOUR COUNCIL AND YOUR MONEY BEING SPENT!

#### **Pro-Life Report for November 2015**


Many thanks for all those who supported the recent 40 Days for Life Campaign. We had another save this year that we know of and some memorable prayers vigils there especially on several Saturdays.





Council 5300 will be aiding the many Christian refugees in the middle east by raising money for the Christian Refugee Relief Fund through the sale of olive wood crosses.

The crosses are manufactured by craftsmen in the middle east and sold by the Knights of Columbus Supreme Council for \$5 apiece. Our council will sell the crosses at various events for \$10. For each cross sold the council will recoup its \$5 outlay and donate \$5 to the Christian Refugee Relief Fund.

Please support our persecuted Christian brothers and sisters by buying and helping to sell these crosses. They make good gifts at a low price and the olive wood is beautiful. The council voted to start the program with \$75 and brother Rich Scholl will head it up.

We especially need gift items for children to buy in the Children's Shopping Corner. If you have NEW gift items to donate, or if you can solicit a gift certificate from




