The Christmas Boutique will be held at the St. Raphael's Parish Hall on Sunday, December 6 open from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m.

Come on by and support your Council in keeping Christ in Christmas. You can purchase Christmas cards that help recipients reflect on the real meaning of Christmas. Think of giving these cards as evangelization, which Pope Francis has urged us to do. Cards are available in packages of 10 to 24 cards for \$6 to \$9. Also, you can purchase Olive Wooden Crosses made by Middle East Christians. For each \$10 Cross, \$5 is donated to the Middle East Christian Refugee Fund organized by the Knight of Columbus Supreme Council, and \$5 goes to Council 5300 to purchase a new cross for sale. 100% of the \$5 donation goes to relief efforts. The Relief Fund will give some hope to Christian refugees, our brothers in Christ, at Christmas time. Pro-Life Report for October 2015

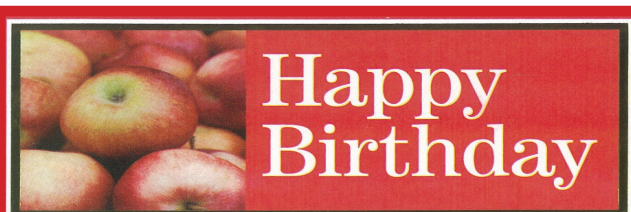

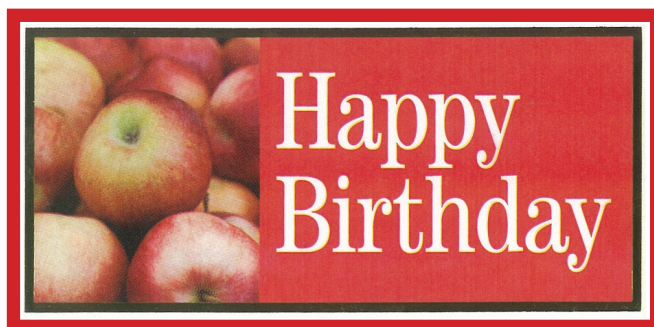

For years the complete Christmas Manger was stored at Henry and Georgia Borgaro's home. Al stated, "The late Emma Kunze gave us the pine greens for many years and son Herb has supplied the hay for the manger since the beginning. Pastor Edward Hempfling originally wanted a full manger setting with all the animals and other statues, but space prevented that in 1961 in the old church. Today little children leave personal messages to Jesus at the manger. The beautiful setting will remain in the Church from December 15 through Sunday, January 11 according to Luis Nungaray. Special thanks go to Luis and his helpers who do this special work of beauty each Christmas season.

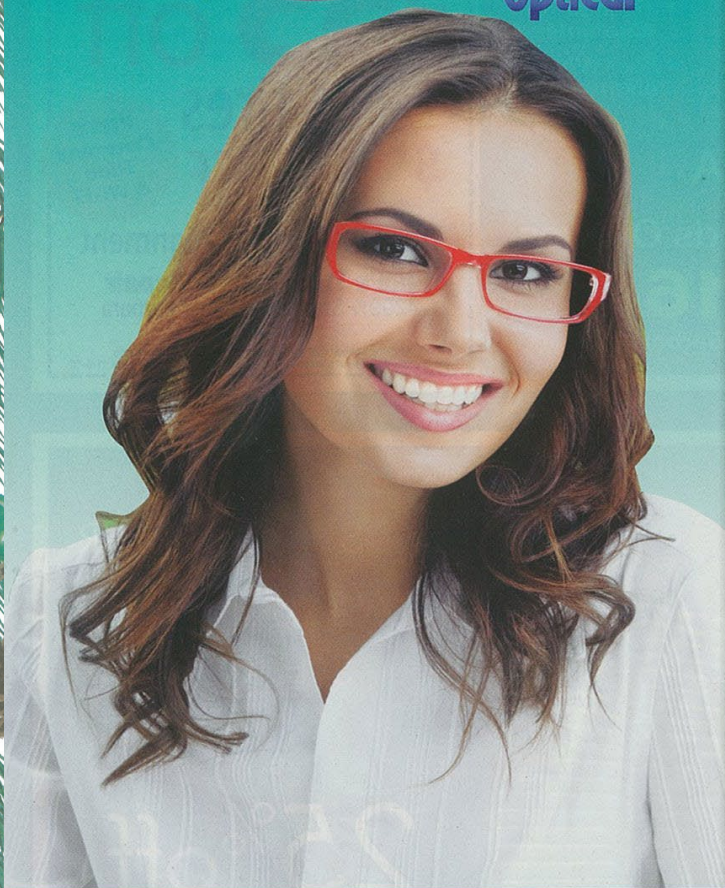
Most memorable experiences as a priest:
