
In Memory of MARIO F. BORGATELLO

April 18, 1918 - August 15, 2013

Mario, at age 18, joined the Knights of Columbus Council #1684.

Mario F. Borgatello was born on April 18, 1918 in Santa Barbara, California, the youngest of five children to Secondo Borgatello and Josephine Prato Borgatello. Six short months after Mario was born, Secondo passed away leaving Josephone to raise five young children on her own. Times were very tough and they did the best that they could to get by on a daily basis with much help from Santa Barbara County Social Services. As a way to feed the family, Josephine began providing boarding for the immigrants that would come from Italy as gardeners and stone masons.

In the late 1920's Mario and his older brother Charles started collecting food scraps to help feed the hogs that their mom was raising. Over the years this hauling business has evolved into what is now known as MarBorg Industries. In 1938 Mario met Marguerite Saulsburg, the love of his life. They were married in November of 1941 at St. Joan of Arc Church in Las Vegas. Mario and Marguerite (Peggy) were married for 70-years and had two sons, David and Mario A. Peggy died June 1, 2011. Since then the family has blossomed to 7 grandchildren and 21 great-grandchildren. Grandchildren are Theresa Carlson, Anthony Borgatello, Brian Borgatello, Andrea Forey, Kathy Koeper, Kristine Trockmorton, Kerri Boeddeker. He was born on April 6, 1934. His wife Pat died a few years earlier.


No services were held.

1,143 Diners Enjoy Delicious Fish Fry Meals, Desserts, Beverages for 6 Weeks

The annual Lenten Fish Fry Dinners attracted 1,143 persons during the six weeks the Knights of Columbus Goleta Valley Council 5300 members prepared these delicious Friday evening meals in the Parish Hall.

According to Knight Paul Curzan, who sells the tickets and keeps superb records of attendees (adults, children, complimentary), the figures were: week 1 - 166, week 2 - 194,

week 3 - 176, week 4 - 217, week 5 - 186 and week 6 - 204.

Evelina Curzan, wife of Curzan, is to be commended also for her photogenic work in taking all the colorful and interesting photos of guests and workers. Last month's Knightline spotlighted 26 pictures and this edition features two pages.

Curzan stated, "Now that we've gone back to the Swai, which has been our mainstay for a number of years, we're getting lots of compliments on the fish, but some folks have not come back." He added, "It's going to take time for the word to spread and it may be some time before we hit numbers like 262 again - back four or five years ago."

Curzan acknowledged that about 30-workers made up the crew each week. A few of the kitchen crew men were not Knights and obviously all the women who helped in so many ways were not Knights and some were not even spouses of Knights.

Sir Knight Felix Sanchez who manages the Bar (beer, wine, soft drinks) stated sales was very good. While the FOCUS (Fellowship of Catholic University Students) group was not present at all of the six evenings, they reported to Curzan that they took in \$1,550 of donations for their ministry. Curzan added, "For each \$50 donation FOCUS received, the Knights donated two dinner tickets (\$20 value) that were given to the donor. In addition, the group from St. Mark's University Parish received other smaller monetary donations also and that went to making up the total collected."

The Operation Outreach Ministry group that sold desserts at our dinners made a total net of approximately \$516 for their efforts. This supports their ministry in providing Thanksgiving dinner to seniors, coordinating the St. Raphael Parish Directory publication, etc.

Little at a time. I couldn't share them with my family or they would have been all gone fast.




Essays were judged on:


 Content - How thoroughly is the topic examined;
