Pro-Life Report for May 2016

On the 23rd of April there was a Prayer Vigil at Planned Parenthood, protesting the sale of baby body parts by PP. This was part of a nationwide vigil held at hundreds of PP locations throughout the country. This was a non-denominational event, but the majority of the people there were from Saint Raphael's.

Planned Parenthood's own statistics tell us that when someone is praying outside PP, the no-show percentage is 75%. This shows the power of peaceful prayer. Several of the people from 40 Days for Life are now going there on a regular basis. Hopefully we can continue to increase our presence there.

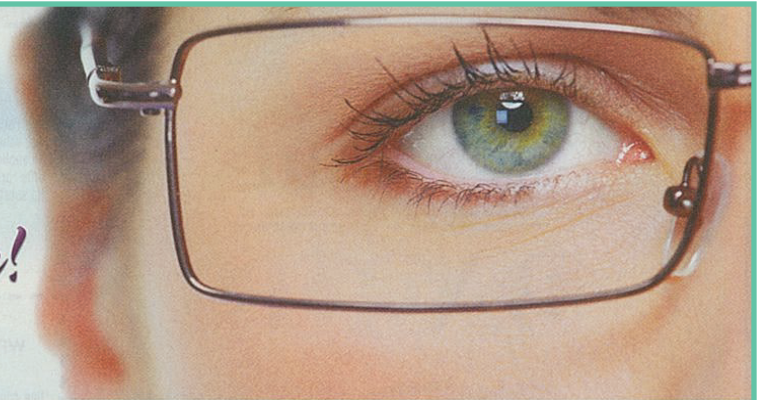
