Jack Turney Now Serving as 55th Grand Knight

Jack Howe Turney, Jr., has assumed the Grand Knight leadership of the Knights of Columbus Goleta Valley Council 5300, serving for the 2016-17 Columbian year. Brother Jack is the 55th Grand Knight in the 56-year history of the Council.

The native of Ross, California became a Knight in 1996, a 2nd Degree in 1996, a 3rd Degree in 1997 and 4th Degree in 2001. His sponsor was Tom Puerling. Jack noted, "The best thing about being a KC member is being part of an active and dynamic family." He would like to see the KC's build on some of the events that were done in the past.

The reason he decided to become a Knight was "to give back to the community." Jack has held the important positions of Treasurer and Chancellor. At St. Raphael's Church, Jack serves as Eucharistic Minister and is active with the St. Vincent de Paul Society.

The 81-year has resided in Goleta since 1960 coming from Germany. Jack stated, "I have extra-special reasons for my appreciation of Father-Monsignor Stephen Downes as he baptized me in 1991."

As a youngster Jack attended grade schools in San Francisco and Carmel and graduated from Carmel High School. He proceeded to earn an AA Degree from Monterey Peninsula College.

Jack's parents, Mansfield Sr., and Pearl were proud parents of two boys and a girl, Mansfield Jr. (aka Jack) and John and daughter Gerry. They lived in Petaluma, Calif. Jack was born on March 1, 1935.

In 1957-1961 Jack served in the Air Force and stationed in Texas, Mississippi, South Carolina, Georgia and Germany. While in Munich, Germany he met Christa Jaeckisch (native of Germany) and they were married on April 25, 1961 at the Santa Barbara Mission.

They are proud parents of three children: Christine 55, Ann 54 and Susan 50. Also proud grandparents of Rose 35, Francis 32, Anthony 29, Alex 23, Lauren 21 and Ciera 20.

His employment history includes 17 years with Applied Magnetics, 12 years self employed and 12 years as General Manager at Enerpro in Goleta.

Jack's favorite community involvement is serving as Chairman of the Goleta Valley Hospital Volunteer Leadership Committee. Woodworking and painting are Jack's hobbies.

Christa's community/parish involvements include Goleta Valley Cottage Hospital, Little Garden Club, Stitchery Club, Military Rosary Makers Group.

Jack and Christa have enjoyed traveling to many countries (Germany, Holland, Belgium, Denmark, Sweden, Finland, Norway, Estonia, Poland, Russia, Costa Rica, Mexico, Canada) and all 50 states.

A parishioner since 1964, Wayne was ordained Deacon on June 10, 1995 at Blessed Sacrament Church in Hollywood, Calif.

Born in Newark, New Jersey his parents, brothers, and sisters moved to Goleta. His father Frank died in March 1987. His mother Mariam died in Aug. 1988.

Wayne is a UCSB graduate, June 1969 and was prolific in many areas: daily newspaper, yearbook, radio station and

editor of theorientation handbook. He was part of the dedication of the Thomas M. Storke Student Communications Building. He remembers escorting Tom Storke to the top of the 188' Tower during construction just before they removed the scaffolding.

Deacon Wayne wrote a regular column in the SPIRIT parish newspaper titled "Servant's Corner."

He worked for the U.S. Postal Service from June 1967 until retirement in 2002. He served as manager for 28 years. He served as National Vice President for the National Assn. of Postal Supervisers from 1974 to 2002.

From July 2002 until August 2007 Deacon Wayne served as Business Manager of St. Raphael's Church.

Wayne became a member of the Knights of Columbus, Council 5300 on August 8, 1983. With his expertise in publications, he soon became Editor of the Knightline serving for several years.

The 1996 Centennial Yearbook, 324-pages, was co-edited by Deacon Wayne.

He has served as Chaplain of the Boy Scouts for many years. Currently Deacon Wayne is an elementary teacher.

From 1963 to Nov. 1992 Joe served as UCSB's Communications Director.



In Its 56-Year History Since 1961 55 Grand Knights in Council 5300

The history of the Knights of Columbus, Goleta Valley Council 5300, goes back to 1961 when Walter Daniel Merrigan, Jr., served two years as Grand Knight. Merrigan became a Knight at age 18 in Las Vegas before moving to Santa Barbara and becoming the Grand Knight at age 32. Fifty-five Knights have served as Grand Knights since then with Jack H. Turney, Jr. the current installed leader for the 2016-17 Columbian year.


The Knights have been volunteering to work precincts in the Santa Barbara County elections since the mid-1990's.
