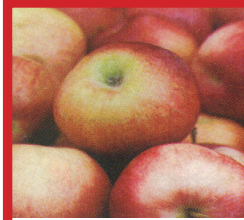
Pro-Life Report for August 2016

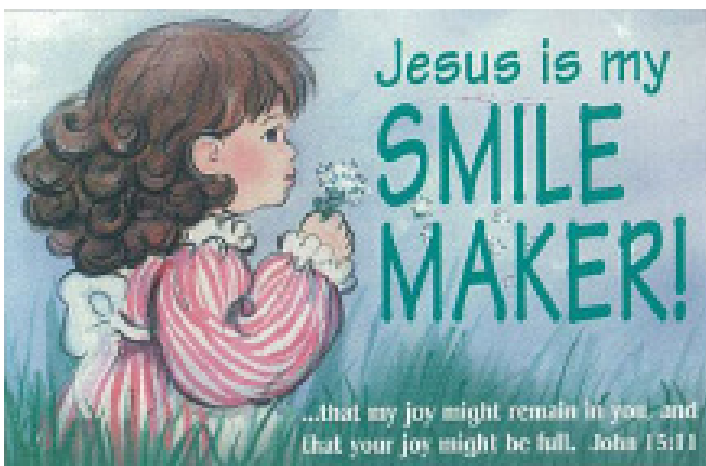

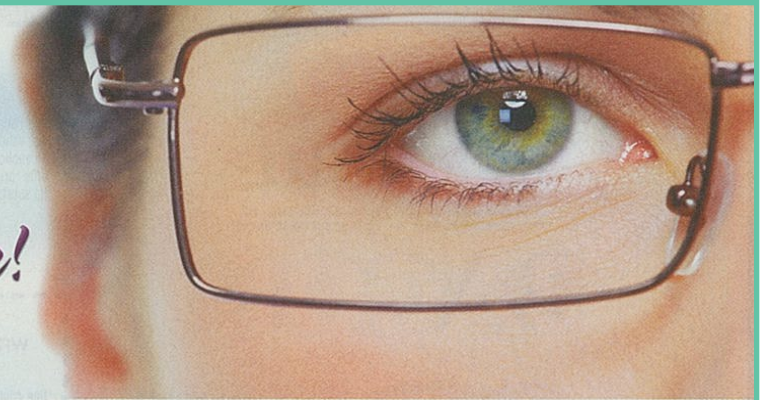

Joe married Geri Ann Pechanec on August 20, 1955 in Holy Cross Church in Portland by Rev. Thomas R. Jackson.

Joe's parents John Gaspar and Anna Elizabeth were from Slovakia who came to USA before WW I as were Geri's grandparents.

Proud parents of 3 sons: Christopher Joseph, Kelly Michael and Joseph Anthony and daughter Linda Suzanne. The boys were Altar Servers at St. Raphael and Linda was asked by Pastor Henry Van Son to be an Altar Girl with her brothers.

Proud grandparents of Kurt Michael, Sarah Jean, Ryan Patrick, Rachel Renee, Hannah Rose and Rebecca Ann. Great granddaughter Riley Belle.

Members of St. Raphael Church since July 1963. Joe became a member of the Knights of Columbus on May 13, 1996.

Served in the U.S. Army during the Korean War stationed at Fort Ord, Ca., Fort Lewis, Wash., and Augsburg, Germany, 1953-55.

Geri graduated from Holy Cross Grade School, St. Mary's Academy and worked for the U.S. National Bank prior to her marriage. Joe graduated from St. Patrick's Grade School, Roosevelt High School and earned his BA and MA degrees in Education at the University of Portland in 1953 and 1958.

Joe taught high school journalism in Oregon for eight years before taking the UCSB position in 1963 as the Communications

Director, a job held until retirement in November 1993.

Geri has been active in various adventures although for many years her major concern was taking care of Kelly who had suffered from olivoponto cerebellum degenerataive disease. He completed his studies at SBCC and earned a Library Science degree in June 1979. He died on Oct. 9, 2004. Geri loves singing, playing the piano, had taken many, many Adult Ed Classes and was active with the Santa Barbara Woman's Club.

For 32-years Joe had been the Editor of St. Raphael's SPIRIT newspaper which grew in size from a 6 1/2" x 8 1/2" format to the tabloid size printed in full color. For the 1996 Parish Centennial, Joe and Deacon Wayne M. Rascati co-edited the impressive 324-page year-book with assistance from many parishioners. He also was Editor of the KC Knightline for a few years and mailed it for many years.

Joe and Geri enjoyed taking special vacations to Italy (with eight couples from St. Raphael), Ireland, England, Scotland, Wales (with Bruce and Alice Velasco), Slovakia, Czech Republic, Poland, Spain, Hungary, Austria, Germany, Switzerland, France, Mexico, Canada and Hawaii.
