Retirement has provided time for much 'deferred home maintenance' and some travel. Favorite trips included Isreal (1989) and Greece and Turkey (2005).

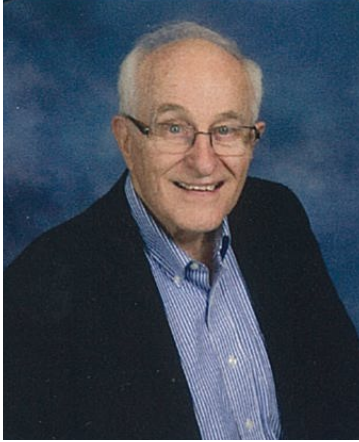

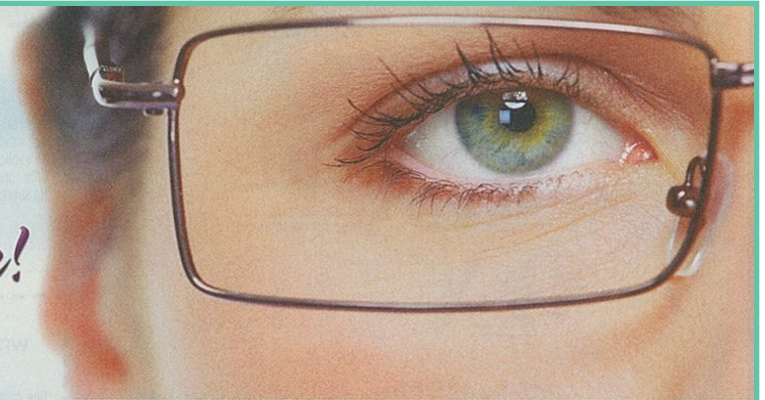
