




Happy 78th Birthday on Nov. 29 and Happy 52nd Anniversary on May 30, 2016

Dick worked for nine years with General Research Corp., and later 18 years with Tecolote Research, Inc.


Retirement has provided time for much 'deferred home maintenance' and some travel. Favorite trips included Isreal (1989) and Greece and Turkey (2005).
